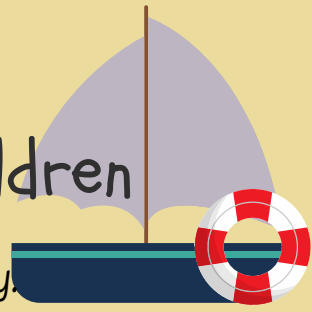




6 Strategies When Leaving Your Children
